Marshall Public Schools, a mid-west school system of 2200 students is seeking applicants for the following position which will become available with the beginning of the 2008 – 2009 school year:

**Middle School Orchestra and Classroom Music.**

This position is responsible for orchestra classes for grades 4-8. In addition, individual and small group lessons are provided grades 5-8 throughout the week. Classroom music instruction for grades 5 & 6 is a team teaching arrangement with a veteran general music teacher.

Marshall Public Schools offers a comprehensive orchestra program with two (2) orchestra instructors supporting one (1) primary elementary, one (1) middle level and one (1) secondary level school. The program is well supported by the district and Marshall Music Boosters, a parent organization. This support organization seeks to advance and enhance all music programs in the district. The school district has a partnership with Southwest Minnesota State University, which offers additional music opportunities for advanced students. There are several private string teachers including those who provide instruction in the Suzuki method in the Marshall community. The Marshall Area Fine Arts Council and The Schwan Food Company are active supporters of the arts in Marshall. Their newest venture is the Imagine Center for the Arts which supports teaching and performing space for music and arts activities. The community is enriched by the presence of the Southwest Minnesota Orchestra, a well established and respected mid-western orchestra which performs in the state of the art Schwan Center for the Performing Arts located in the Marshall High School.
